Sealed [electronic] bids for the Village of Pleasant Prairie, Cooper Road Sanitary Sewer Relay, project will be accepted *via QuestCDN vBid Electronic Bid Service* by 11:00 a.m. (local time) on March 14, 2024; and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

The proposals shall be submitted on the forms furnished with the specifications. Each proposal shall be accompanied by a bid bond of a bonding company duly authorized to do business in the State of Wisconsin in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the proposal. This proposal guarantee shall be subject to forfeiture as provided by law. When submitting an electronic bid, Bidder is required to deliver the original bid bond within 72 hours of bid opening to Cedar Corporation.

SUBCONTRACTORS AND SUPPLIERS” and all Sub-contractors must be pre-qualified prior to award of this Contract.
