**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS
109th AVENUE RECONSTRUCTION**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Village Board of the Village of Pleasant Prairie, Kenosha County, Wisconsin has adopted a preliminary resolution declaring its intention to exercise its police power to levy special assessments pursuant to section 66.0703, Wis. Stats., upon property within the proposed assessment district which include nine properties (8112, 8109, 8121, 8021, 8001, 8000, 8012, 8022, and 8030 109th Avenue) for benefits conferred upon the property for the reconstruction of 109th Avenue. The project generally consists of reconstructing 109th Avenue, beginning at 82nd Street and extending north to 80th Street including roadway base and pavement, storm sewer, inlets, sump laterals, and ditching.

A report, the estimated cost of improvements and a schedule of proposed assessments are on file at the Pleasant Prairie Village Hall, 9915 39th Avenue, and may be inspected there during any business day between the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

You are further notified that the Governing body will hear all interested persons, or their agents or attorneys, concerning matters contained in the preliminary resolution authorizing the assessments and the above-described report **at 6:00 p.m. on the 11th day of March 2024** in the Pleasant Prairie Village Hall. All objections will be considered at this hearing and thereafter the amount of the assessments will be finally determined.
