The Project consists of one prime Contract bid as a Base Bid and one Alternate Bid and generally consists of the following: clearing and grubbing, pavement removal, excavation common, storm sewer, catch basins, storm sump laterals, hydrant assembly, manhole rehabilitations, base aggregate dense, asphaltic concrete pavement, concrete curb & gutter, turf restoration, erosion control, traffic control, and construction staking.
